

# GROINSS-V II

- Multicenter observational study
- Is radiotherapy a safe alternative for lymphadenectomy in vulvar cancer patients with a positive SN ?
  - SN negative: follow-up
  - SN positive: radiotherapy on groin(s) instead of lymphadenectomy
- Stopping rules with respect to number of groin recurrences

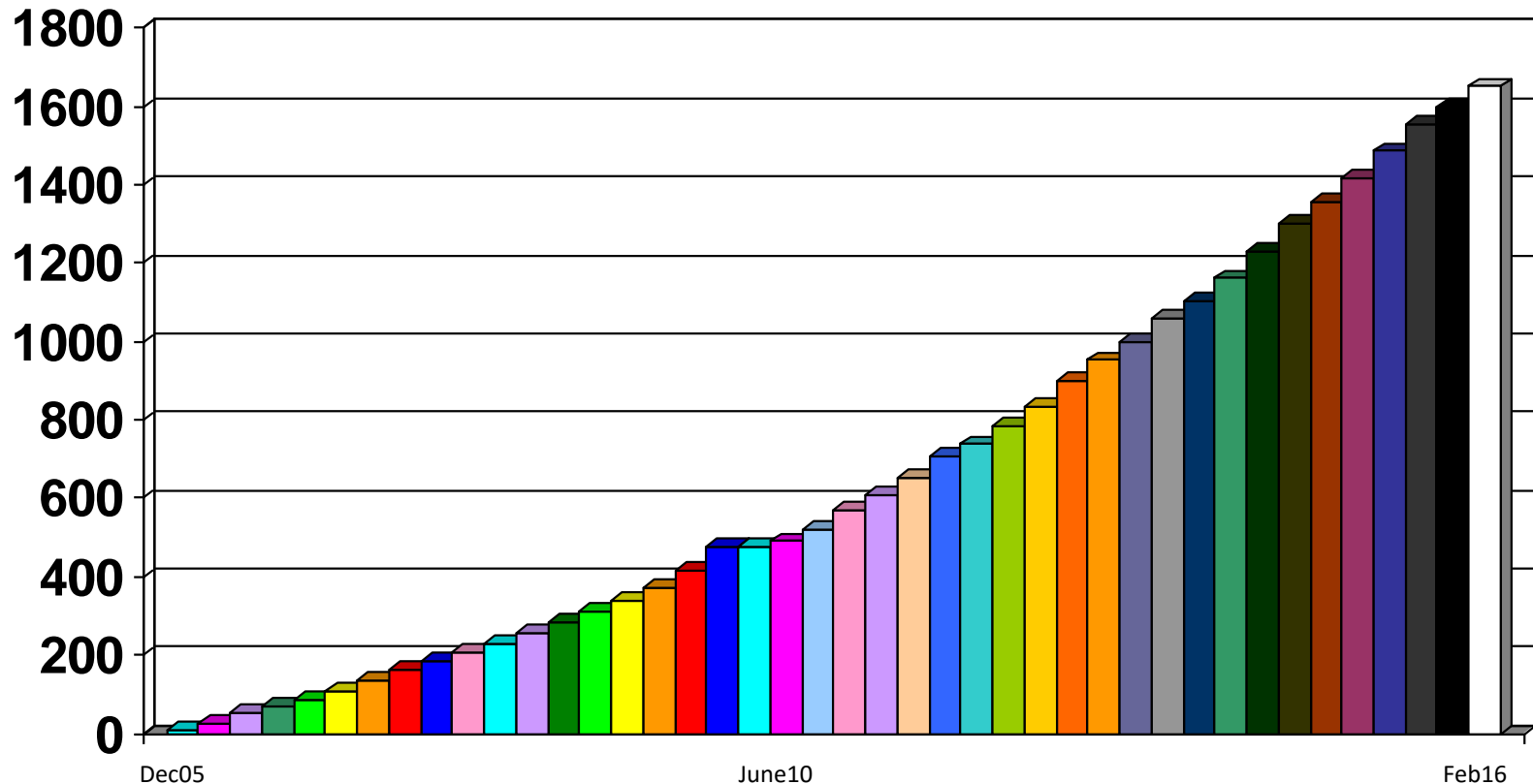

- SN negative:  $n = 1280$  (78%)

# GROINSS-V II

(Update May 2016)

- N = 1651
- SN pos: n = 370
  - SN met  $\leq 2$  mm: n=180
